Whether it's because of the place or the hosts, we find ourselves in the lap of comfort and a sincere welcome. As for the setting, the 9 rooms spaced around the sumptuous garden and swimming pool, offer their irreproachable comfort, authentic charm and a permanent attention to detail -terra cotta floor tiles, furniture and fabrics chosen with taste, decoration simple and refined. We find the same generosity in the dining room – a personalized and lavish breakfast, or dinner derived from an eclectic mix of French and Namibian cuisine, served on tables daintily decorated. Wildlife & bird watching at the waterhole, hiking trails, sparkling pool, relaxing in hammocks, while children play on the playground, beach volleyball, feed animals or horse riding - you choose. Enjoy spectacular sunsets on our sundowner drives or your own balcony. Meals are served in our lapa and our historic breakfast room. Centrally situated on a hilltop, makes us a convenient stopover to/from Waterberg/ Etosha/ cheetahs.



Tuesday – Day 4

Accommodation at Namutoni Resort in a Camping on a Self Catering basis for 1 night.

Namutoni is situated on the eastern side of Etosha and derives its name from the old German fort around which it is built. The presence of the fort gives Namutoni more character than the other rest camps in Etosha, and in terms of accommodation this is probably the best of the three rest camps. During 2007 the accommodation at Namutoni was completely overhauled with the intention of making this a luxury camp inside the Etosha National Park. The Fort, which is for pedestrians only and overlooks the King Nehale waterhole, is the hub of activity with two restaurants, a relaxation lounge, a bar, crafts boutique, curio shop, jewellers and bookstore. An elevated decked walkway along the water-hole provides views of the surrounding scenery, wildlife and spectacular sunsets.

Please note: Camping is strictly on a self-catering basis.



Wednesday – Day 5

Accommodation at Halali Resort in a Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 1 night.

Rooms: Campsite x 1

Strategically located halfway between Okaukuejo and Namutoni, Halali is situated at the base of a dolomite hill, amongst shady Mopane trees. A flood-lit waterhole which is viewed from an elevated vantage point provides exceptional wildlife viewing throughout the day and into the night. Accommodation is provided in family chalets, two and four bed bush chalets and double rooms - all converted with large sliding doors to the outside, to allow visitors to experience and benefit from the peace and tranquillity of the natural surroundings. Other facilities include a restaurant, bar, shop, swimming pool, kiosk (limited stock and supplies) and camping facilities.



Thursday - 06 Oct 2016

Accommodation at Okaukuejo Resort in a Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 1 night.

Okaukuejo Camp is the oldest tourist camp in Etosha and it currently functions as the administrative hub of the park, and the home of the Etosha Ecological Institute. It is situated at the western end of the pan. Accommodation is provided to suit every need, in premier bush chalets overlooking the waterhole; bush chalets and double rooms; or family chalets. Other facilities include a restaurant, bar, shop, swimming pool, kiosk and camping facilities. The main attraction of this camp is that it overlooks a permanent waterhole which is floodlit at night. Here a wide diversity of wildlife congregates and interacts. The spectacle starts at dawn, with animals coming in large numbers to quench their thirst, with the activity continuing throughout the day and deep into the night. In the early evenings, it is not uncommon to have black rhinoceros, elephant and lion all drinking at the same time.

Please note: accommodation is booked on a Bed and Breakfast basis whilst camping is strictly on a Self-catering basis.



Friday – Day 7

Accommodation at Dolomite Camp in a Bush Chalet (2 beds) on a Bed and Breakfast basis for 1 night.

A previously restricted part of the Park, western Etosha, boasts some of the highest numbers of wildlife throughout the Park. The vegetation is mainly Karstveldt and Mopane shrubland with the geology dominated by dolomite formations – fittingly giving the new Camp its name. Nestled in the dolomite outcrops of this vast area of western Etosha National Park, Dolomite Camp will offer its clients an intimate experience of one of the most scenic areas of the Park, an area where previously endangered species like the Black Rhinoceros and Black-Faced Impala have been successfully bred. The Camp will consist of a spacious reception, lounge, bar and restaurant area – offering crimson sunrise and sunset views over the surrounding savannah. From this point, a walkway leads to thatched, en suite chalets of which two are deluxe chalets with own plunge pools – nestled amongst the rocky outcrops, providing privacy and dramatic and panoramic landscape views.



Saturday – Day 8

Accommodation at Palmwag Lodge in a Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 1 night.

Palmwag Lodge is an oasis in the arid landscape of the Damaraland region (or Kunene region, as it is now called) of Namibia. Palmwag Lodge, one of Namibia's most well-known tourist lodges, is situated on the Uniab River in a concession area. This means that you will be able to find a number of plant and animal species unique to Damaraland, including desert elephant, desert black rhino and mountain zebra. The Palmwag area also boasts the largest population of predators (leopard, lion, cheetah and spotted hyena) outside the borders of the Etosha National Park. At Palmwag Lodge, guests are accommodated in thatched bungalows and luxury tents. A child-friendly 8-bed unit is ideal for the travelling family. All accommodation is en-suite.



Sunday – Day 9

Accommodation at Cape Cross Lodge in a Standard Room on a Dinner, Bed & Breakfast basis for 1 night.

Cape Cross Lodge at the Skeleton Coast offers 20 luxury double rooms, classically appointed with attention to detail, yet animate with a rustic charm that is bewitching. Views through the large windows are breathtaking, no matter the time of day or night. The en-suite bathrooms are a statement of elegant simplicity, while the private balconies glow with the warmth of wooden deckchairs and tables, affording unrestricted sea views and an aura of complete respite. The newly developed campsite at Cape Cross Lodge is now officially open. Each of the 21 sites has its own light with switch and a double 220v plug, a washbasin with cold running water, a work surface and a braai. Each site also has its own trip switch. There is a central ablution block with showers with hot and cold running water, flush toilets, hand-wash basins and mirrors. A separate bar for the camper's close to the site. A limited quantity of fuel and diesel will be kept on the premises for the camper's convenience.

Namib Naukluft Park is the largest game park in Africa (40 000 sq. km) and fourth largest in the world. There are four sections in the park: Sossusvlei and Sesriem, Naukluft, Namib section and Sandwich Harbour. Sesriem offers a total of 18 camping sites with communal ablution facilities. Distance between Sesriem and Sossusvlei is 65 kilometres with the last 5 kilometres before Sossusvlei can be negotiated with 4x4 vehicle only. There are several local companies providing shuttle services from 2x4 parking area to Sossusvlei (fee is currently N\$ 87.50 per person). Sesriem Canyon is located only 4 kilometres from Sesriem. The canyon, approximately 2 to 4 million years old, is up to 40 metres deep and about 3 kilometres long. Sossusvlei is one of the places definitely worth to see in Namibia. Huge red sand dunes, camel thorn trees and vlei (shallow water pond) itself, filled occasionally after a good rains are the attractions of the area. Remember: visit dunes as early as possible (temperatures are not that high yet and you can take the best pictures), always carry a water with you, sun block cream is a must, as well as a hat.



Friday – Day 14

Accommodation at Zur Waterkant in a Standard Room on a Bed & Breakfast basis for 2 nights.

The Fish River Canyon can be reached driving down south on B1, turning to B4 towards Luderitz, turning left on C12 and follow signs. The main attraction of the park is Fish River Canyon Hike. Due to extreme temperatures (up to 50 degrees in the summer!) open only during winter time. The canyon, which is 161 kilometres long and up to 550 meters deep, forms part of the conservation area proclaimed a reserve in 1969. The camp site of Hobas is located 10 km from the main viewpoint along the access road to the canyon. There is a kiosk with basic supplies and a swimming pool.



Tuesday – Day 18

Accommodation at Teufelskrallen Tented Lodge in a Standard Tent on a Bed & Breakfast basis for 2 nights.

The fully furnished and comfortably equipped tents come with a large view deck and their own bathroom. Each bathroom is connected to the tent by a short boardwalk. Reception, restaurant and swimming pool are located in the Altes Farmhaus at a distance of 3km from the tents. During hikes and game drives, our guests can experience the breathtaking beauty of the Kalahari with the 30m dunes and the rich wildlife stock.
