Accommodation at De Hollandsche Molen in a Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 2 nights.

Surrounded by its majestic mountains and beautiful vineyards - De Hollandsche Molen is seen as the perfect base from which to explore the Cape Winelands. On our beautiful lush green camping grounds we have 62 marked sites. We boast with 2 modern ablution blocks, which has facilities for disabled people, a launderette with scullery and a unisex bathroom for families with young children. Each site has its own braai stand and access to a 220V Electrical point. We have 13 beautiful self-catering chalets, each with 2 bedrooms which sleeps a maximum of 6 guests (children included). Every chalet has a fully equipped kitchen which includes a fridge, microwave, 2 plate stove with oven and the basic cooking utensils. On the porch there is a built-in braai for each chalet with outdoor-furniture provided. Secure undercover parking is also available. We do have DSTV satellite connection, but please bring own decoder with smartcard to connect.



Monday – Day 3

Accommodation at Ou Skip Holiday Resort in a Campsite (with electricity) on a Self-catering basis for 2 nights.

Our park is situated 26 km from the center of Cape Town, South Africa, providing easy access to major attractions such as long white sandy beaches offering safe swimming as well as many exciting watersports, including windsurfing, kite surfing, paragliding and surfing at the famous Big Bay. Ou Skip is one of the largest caravan parks in the Western Cape of South Africa with sites surrounded by trees and shrubs. There are 206 level grassed sites as well as 12 fully equipped, self catering two bedroomed chalets. The resort has 5 ablution blocks with hot and cold water, baths, showers, scullery, laundry, and ironing facilities. The park also has its own gas (propane) refill and exchange station.

The Fish River Canyon can be reached driving down south on B1, turning to B4 towards Luderitz, turning left on C12 and follow signs. The main attraction of the park is Fish River Canyon Hike. Due to extreme temperatures (up to 50 degrees in the summer!) open only during wintertime. The canyon, which is 161 kilometers long and up to 550 meters deep, forms part of the conservation area proclaimed a reserve in 1969. The camp site of Hobas is located 10 km from the main viewpoint along the access road to the canyon. There is a kiosk with basic supplies and a swimming pool.



Monday - 10 Oct 2016

Accommodation at Desert Horse Inn in a Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 1 night.

The Desert Horse Inn is situated on Klein Aus Vista Nature Reserve, 2km from the small town of Aus, in southern Namibia. The lodge is situated on a 10-hectare farm that borders on the Sperrgebiet (forbidden diamond mining area). This establishment is an ideal stopover between Keetmanshoop, Fish River Canyon, and Luderitz. The Namib Desert Wild Horses are often found near the lodge. The main area at the Desert Horse Inn is built entirely of wood and houses the main reception area and curio shop on the lower floor. A telephone, fax machine and an internet connection are also located here. A staircase to the side takes you to the restaurant, bar and sitting area upstairs. There is also an outside deck area under a shaded roof, where you can sit and enjoy the impressive panoramic views. The main indoor restaurant has high ceilings supported by wooden beams, large windows and it offers a 270° panoramic view. Meals are served either as a buffet, set menu or 'plate serve', depending on the number of guests. The Desert Horse Inn offers 24 luxury rooms with spacious, en-suite bathrooms. Each room has a fridge, fan, mosquito nets, tea/coffee station and an in-room safe.



Tuesday – Day 11

Accommodation at Sesriem Camping in a Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 2 nights.

Rooms: Campsite x 1

Namib Naukluft Park is the largest game park in Africa (40 000 sq. km) and fourth largest in the world. There are four sections in the park: Sossusvlei and Sesriem, Naukluft, Namib section and Sandwich Harbour. Sesriem offers a total of 18 camping sites with communal ablution facilities. Distance between Sesriem and Sossusvlei is 65 kilometers with the last 5 kilometres before Sossusvlei can be negotiated with 4x4 vehicle only. There are several local companies providing shuttle services from 2x4 parking area to Sossusvlei (fee is currently N\$ 87.50 per person). Sesriem Canyon is located only 4 kilometers from Sesriem. The canyon, approximately 2 to 4 million years old, is up to 40 meters deep and about 3 kilometers long. Sossusvlei is one the places definitely worth to see in Namibia. Huge red sand dunes, camel thorn trees and vlei (shallow water pond) itself, filled occasionally after a good rain are the attractions of the area. Remember: visit dunes as early as possible (temperatures are not that high yet and you can take the best pictures), always carry a water with you, sun block cream is a must, as well as a hat.



Thursday – Day 13

Accommodation at Secret Garden Guesthouse in a Standard Room on a Bed and Breakfast basis for 2 nights.

Rooms: Standard Room x 1

The Secret Garden Guesthouse in Swakopmund, Namibia's Premier Holiday & Tourist Destination on the famous 'Skeleton Coast' offers you all the comforts of your own home. All the 6 double en-suite bedrooms and 3 'Comfort' double en-suite bedrooms face onto a secluded courtyard. There are also 2 Luxury suites with private balcony. Breakfast is included and we have Bar-B-que facilities. New to Secret Garden is our Bistro where you can enjoy "Meal of the Day" and delicious Pizzas. Situated in the heart of "Old Swakopmund" you can explore the town and amenities on foot. There is a secure parking area and children are welcome.



Saturday – Day 15

Accommodation at Mowani Mountain Camp in a Campsite (no electricity) on a Self-catering basis for 1 night.

In the heat, dust and stunning landscapes of Damaraland, there is a sanctuary – Mowani Mountain Camp. Dwarfed by massive ochre boulders, the camp is absorbed into the landscape, making it one with our shared history of life in this prehistoric land. Every soft curve or ragged edge frames the landscape in a different way, as if you are seeing for the first time, every time. Game drives along ancient dry riverbeds reveal life that in its sparseness reminds us just how special it is. Rare, desert dwelling elephants, springbok, gemsbok and jackal roam these plains, while their images are found etched in the rocks at Twyfelfontein, Namibia's first World Heritage Site. Relax in a sparkling pool, enjoy a sun-downer, and pause, breathe in and know that this is luxury as nature intended it. Secluded amongst the boulders, Mowani's guest rooms are a testament to the surroundings, where a sense of elegance and earthiness prevails. Winner of an architectural eco-design award in Germany, the organic nature of the design is felt through the camp. Colours, textures and comforts envelope you, while the vaulted cathedral like thatched ceilings are Africa's way of paying homage to nature. Mowani offers 13 en-suite rooms with views across the valley or hilltop vistas and 2 luxury suites, with open-air bathrooms, a spacious lounge and deck for enjoying meals in peaceful seclusion. There are also 7 campsites with stunning views across the valley and private ablution facilities.



Sunday – Day 16

Accommodation at Grootberg Lodge in a Hoada Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 2 nights.

Rooms: Hoada Campsite x 1

Perched on the lip of the Grootberg Plateau, with an infinite view down the Klip River Valley lies the Grootberg Lodge. Eleven tastefully decorated en-suite chalets with hardwood decks offer you an almost impossible view, which rivals all else. From the comfort of your bed you can soak in the mournful call of the bokmakierie as it echoes off the opposing cliffs. 12000 hectares of exclusive use area ensure a myriad of Damaraland flora and fauna on display, with desert elephant and the occasional black rhino ghosting an appearance in the harsh landscape. For travellers making the journey between Etosha and Swakopmund, this lodge provides the ideal midway stopover, whilst allowing guests to experience the true wilderness that is Damaraland. Please note that there are no connections for electricity for camping at Grootberg Lodge.



Tuesday – Day 18

Accommodation at Halali Resort in a Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 2 nights.

Rooms: Campsite x 1

Strategically located halfway between Okaukuejo and Namutoni, Halali is situated at the base of a dolomite hill, amongst shady Mopane trees. A flood-lit waterhole which is viewed from an elevated vantage point provides exceptional wildlife viewing throughout the day and into the night. Accommodation is provided in family chalets, two and four bed bush chalets and double rooms - all converted with large sliding doors to the outside, to allow visitors to experience and benefit from the peace and tranquility of the natural surroundings. Other facilities include a restaurant, bar, shop, swimming pool, kiosk (limited stock and supplies) and camping facilities.



Thursday – Day 20

Accommodation at Namutoni Resort in a Camping on a Self-catering basis for 1 night.

Rooms: Camping x 1

Namutoni is situated on the eastern side of Etosha and derives its name from the old German fort around which it is built. The presence of the fort gives Namutoni more character than the other rest camps in Etosha, and in terms of accommodation this is probably the best of the three rest camps. During 2007 the accommodation at Namutoni was completely overhauled with the intention of making this a luxury camp inside the Etosha National Park. The Fort, which is for pedestrians only and overlooks the King Nehale waterhole, is the hub of activity with two restaurants, a relaxation lounge, a bar, crafts boutique, curio shop, jewellers and bookstore. An elevated decked walkway along the waterhole provides views of the surrounding scenery, wildlife and spectacular sunsets. Please note: Camping is strictly on a self-catering basis.



Friday – Day 21

Accommodation at Waterberg Plateau Resort in a Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 1 night.

Waterberg Camp is the gateway to the Waterberg Plateau, one of the most spectacular features of the northern region, towering some 200 meters above the surrounding landscape, with sheer cliffs and fascinating rock formations. The Waterberg Camp has recently been re-developed. Accommodation is provided in comfortable premier bush chalets, two and four bed bush chalets and double rooms, all nestled along the base of the Waterberg Plateau cliffs, amongst towering trees. The restaurant, bar and kiosk are housed in the historic Rasthaus, originally built in 1908 and used as a police post for several years. A shop, swimming pool and camping sites are also available.

Please note: accommodation is booked on Bed and Breakfast whilst camping is strictly Self Catering.



Saturday – Day 22

Accommodation at Vondelhof Guesthouse in a Standard Room on a Bed and Breakfast basis for 1 night.

Rooms: Standard Room x 1

Accommodation and continental breakfast buffet, VAT and tourism levy.

If clients wish to have a hot breakfast, they will be charged directly.

Vondelhof Guest House is a small and informal retreat offering highly-personalised service. The sparkling blue swimming pool, a veranda overlooking lush tropical gardens and a jungle-gym for kids offer ample opportunity to relax. In order to stay in touch with the outside world, a computer is available in reception to e-mail and to surf on the Internet. Vondelhof is centrally located at a 5 minutes walking distance of Windhoek's attractive city center with its parks, museums, restaurants and many other attractions. The rooms are spacious and comfortable and decorated with an African touch. All rooms have en-suite bathroom, TV, telephone, mini-bar, safe, fan and coffee/tea facilities. Although Windhoek is not listed as a malaria-area, mosquitoes do occur especially in the rainy season. We therefore provide mosquito nets in all of our bedrooms.
