Transfers: Windhoek Airport - Windhoek Guesthouse Per Person

Namib Naukluft Park is the largest game park in Africa (40 000 sq. km) and fourth largest in the world. There are four sections in the park: Sossusvlei and Sesriem, Naukluft, Namib section and Sandwich Harbour. Sesriem offers a total of 18 camping sites with communal ablution facilities. Distance between Sesriem and Sossusvlei is 65 kilometers with the last 5 kilometres before Sossusvlei can be negotiated with 4x4 vehicle only. There are several local companies providing shuttle services from 2x4 parking area to Sossusvlei (fee is currently N\$ 87.50 per person). Sesriem Canyon is located only 4 kilometers from Sesriem. The canyon, approximately 2 to 4 million years old, is up to 40 meters deep and about 3 kilometers long. Sossusvlei is one the places definitely worth to see in Namibia. Huge red sand dunes, camel thorn trees and vlei (shallow water pond) itself, filled occasionally after a good rain are the attractions of the area. Remember: visit dunes as early as possible (temperatures are not that high yet and you can take the best pictures), always carry water with you, sun block cream is a must, as well as a hat.



Tuesday – Day 4

Accommodation at Sea Breeze Guest House in a Standard Room on a Bed and Breakfast basis for 2 nights.

Thursday – Day 6

Accommodation at Mowani Mountain Camp in a Campsite (no electricity) on a Self-catering basis for 2 nights.

Rooms: Campsite (no electricity) x 1

In the heat, dust and stunning landscapes of Damaraland, there is a sanctuary – Mowani Mountain Camp. Dwarfed by massive ochre boulders, the camp is absorbed into the landscape, making it one with our shared history of life in this prehistoric land. Every soft curve or ragged edge frames the landscape in a different way, as if you are seeing for the first time, every time. Game drives along ancient dry riverbeds reveal life that in its sparseness reminds us just how special it is. Rare, desert dwelling elephants, springbok, gemsbok and jackal roam these plains, while their images are found etched in the rocks at Twyfelfontein, Namibia's first World Heritage Site. Relax in a sparkling pool, enjoy a sundowner, and pause, breathe in and know that this is luxury as nature intended it. Secluded amongst the boulders, Mowani's guest rooms are a testament to the surroundings, where a sense of elegance and earthiness

prevails. Winner of an architectural eco-design award in Germany, the organic nature of the design is felt through the camp. Colours, textures and comforts envelope you, while the vaulted cathedral like thatched ceilings are Africa's way of paying homage to nature. Mowani offers 13 en-suite rooms with views across the valley or hilltop vistas and 2 luxury suites, with open-air bathrooms, a spacious lounge and deck for enjoying meals in peaceful seclusion. There are also 7 campsites with stunning views across the valley and private ablution facilities.



Saturday – Day 8

Accommodation at Okaukuejo Resort in a Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 1 night.

Okaukuejo Camp is the oldest tourist camp in Etosha and it currently functions as the administrative hub of the park, and the home of the Etosha Ecological Institute. It is situated at the western end of the pan. Accommodation is provided to suit every need, in premier bush chalets overlooking the waterhole; bush chalets and double rooms; or family chalets. Other facilities include a restaurant, bar, shop, swimming pool, kiosk and camping facilities. The main attraction of this camp is that it overlooks a permanent waterhole which is floodlit at night. Here a wide diversity of wildlife congregates and interacts. The spectacle starts at dawn, with animals coming in large numbers to quench their thirst, with the activity continuing throughout the day and deep into the night. In the early evenings, it is not uncommon to have black rhinoceros, elephant and lion all drinking at the same time.

Please note: accommodation is booked on a Bed and Breakfast basis whilst camping is strictly on a Self-catering basis.



Sunday – Day 9

Accommodation at Namutoni Resort in a Camping on a Self-catering basis for 1 night.

Rooms: Camping x 1

Namutoni is situated on the eastern side of Etosha and derives its name from the old German fort around which it is built. The presence of the fort gives Namutoni more character than the other rest camps in Etosha, and in terms of accommodation this is probably the best of the three rest camps. During 2007 the accommodation at Namutoni was completely overhauled with the intention of making this a luxury camp inside the Etosha National Park. The Fort, which is for pedestrians only and overlooks the King Nehale waterhole, is the hub of activity with two restaurants, a relaxation lounge, a bar, crafts boutique, curio shop, jewellers and bookstore. An elevated decked walkway along the waterhole provides views of the surrounding scenery, wildlife and spectacular sunsets.

Please note: Camping is strictly on a self-catering basis.



Monday – Day 10

Accommodation at N'kwazi Lodge in a Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 1 night.

Rooms: Campsite x 1

Namibia's n'Kwazi lodge is situated in the north of the country, 21km east of Rundu. It has reasonable accommodation rates, environment friendly bungalows, including scrumptious breakfasts, optional lunch packs and dinner buffets. We also have a camping site, if you need to stay in your own tent or camper. Our tourist accommodation is tucked away along the Okavango river side, with additional guided community tours, river cruises, horse rides and tribal dance shows. Get to experience the n'Kwazi lodge, and, take with you memories never to be forgotten. During your stay at Namibia's n'Kwazi lodge, you may want to further your expeditions. Birds such as the Fish Eagle (n'Kwazi) and Swomp Bobos may be seen, but, with an optional Lunch pack, wildlife conservation parks are just a few hours away.



Tuesday – Day 11

Accommodation at Popa Falls Resort in a Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 1 night.

Rooms: Campsite x 1

Popa Falls Camp is your gateway to the north - eastern corner of Namibia - with its perennial rivers, magnificent indigenous woodlands, riverine forests, floodplains and reed - lined channels. It is the ideal base from which to explore the Mahango Game Park, with over 450 species of birds recorded. A wide variety of wildlife species, including elephant, hippo, buffalo, crocodile, red Lechwe, reedbuck, roan and sable antelope, and if you're lucky, even the elusive Sitatunga antelope can be observed. The 'falls' are in fact a series of cascades created by a quartzite ledge that causes the river to split into numerous channels. They can be accessed on foot from the rest camp. Tigerfish, Three spot and Greenheaded tilapia are just some of the species of game fish that occur in the Kavango River making it a popular destination for anglers. Built on the southern banks of the Kavango River from local timber and thatch; the small, secluded camp offers simple but comfortable accommodation in idyllic surroundings.



Wednesday – Day 12

Accommodation at Camp Kwando in a Private Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 1 night.

Rooms: Private Campsite x 1

Camp Kwando is divided into different accommodations. The island accommodates eight thatched tents, each one with two beds. Every bed is equipped with a mosquito net. Built on poles with a terrace overlooking the river, these bungalows will allow you to do some fishing from the deck. The campsite is situated between the main building and the island. Its surface is covered by trees which provide shade during the hotter hours of the day. It allows for about ten camping spots on a carefully maintained lawn. The facilities provide with showers, toilets and basins, as well as places to do your laundry. Hot and cold water is provided. The three larger bungalows are also available on higher ground, built on high poles, made of wood and canvas, along with thatched roofs. Conveniently placed in the middle of the trees, they allow for an incredible view on the Botswana plains. Each bungalow has a large bedroom, stylishly furnished; a large en-suite bathroom as well as an expanding terrace. Between game drives and swamp boat trips, our swimming pool is there for you, close to the tents and the island, filtered and cleaned to the standards you may expect. Around it, you will relax in the shady area, where long chairs are conveniently placed on the grass garden.



Thursday – Day 13

Accommodation at Kubu Lodge in a Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 1 night.

All rooms have fly screens and are naturally ventilated and have ceiling fans. A tropical courtyard provides privacy and exclusivity. Guests can enjoy a swim in the crystal clear saline swimming pool. A thatched gazebo provides a cool surrounding to relax and revitalize. There is a choice of Continental or English breakfast. Self drive guests have access to the safe indoor parking. Distance from the Victoria Falls Airport is 25km.

Nata Lodge is well located, approximately 10km from Nata on the main Nata-Francistown road. This is on the main tourist route to Okavango Delta, Chobe National Park, Victoria Falls Zimbabwe/Zambia and the Caprivi Strip in Namibia.

An oasis set among the Mokolwane palms on the edge of the pans. It is ideally situated close to the entrance to the Nata Sanctuary and is just off the main road, 10 km from Nata village. This is the junction to the Okavango, Chobe and Francistown areas. The Nata River delta feeds the Sua Pan in the Nata sanctuary and forms the breeding ground for a host of water birds including pelicans and flamingo in their thousands, transforming the shoreline into a pink haze blending into the western sky. Nata Lodge offers guided tours in open safari vehicles into the sanctuary, not to be missed. Nata Lodge offers 22 Luxury thatched chalets built on stilts and set in rustic African style, with bathroom en-suite including indoor bath and outdoor shower and now boats air-conditioning. 10 custom designed meru tents set on wooden decks with en suite bathroom and outdoor showers. The campsite surroundings offer peace and tranquility with backdrop being that of the Botswana night sky. The lodge's campsite is able to accommodate 150 pax and the ablution area's are stylish with semi open showers offering hot and cold water for that true African feeling. The campsite has central electrical power banks for those requiring electricity. Socket is standard RSA 3 pin round plug 240v.



Tuesday – Day 18

Accommodation at Planet Baobab in a Bakalanga Hut (ZAR) on a Bed and Breakfast basis for 2 nights.

The average age of each tree; 4000 years and beyond, the boundless salt pans of the Makgadikgadi, a lunar landscape the size of Switzerland - these are only some of the aspects of this remarkable lodge. Thankfully, the funkiest bar in the Kalahari awaits your pleasure, a well-known watering hole for travellers of every description and the more colourful characters from Maun. At any one time, locals jostle the cross-continentals who have slogged it through the bush, and worse, to get here. Just a stone's throw from all this beer and bustle is the elephant's paddling pool. Oblivious to Guests crouching in the nearby trees, the elephants and travellers mostly ignore each other. At Planet Baobab, you can sleep in traditionally styled Bakalanga huts with en-suite showers, curl up in a Bushmen hut complete in every detail, pitch your tent, or park your 4 x 4.



Thursday – Day 20

Accommodation at Thamalakane River Lodge in a Babbler Chalets on a Bed and Breakfast basis for 1 night.

Thamalakane River Lodge is situated on the banks of the Thamalakane River, just 19kms from Maun and en-route to the famous Moremi Game Reserve. The rambling lodge has an idyllic setting and is committed to service excellence. The pool overlooks the river and has inviting hammocks hanging under a character gazebo with loungers positioned around the pool. The 10 individual luxury stone and thatch en-suite chalets are nestled in the shade of the riverine trees, twin and doubles are available. The spacious chalet interiors have a feature stone wall with an en-suite bathroom consisting of a shower, hand-basin and toilet. Rooms are equipped with tea and coffee making facilities, ceiling fans and mosquito nets. Rooms are well ventilated with a unique "skylight type" wall. Each chalet has a private patio with a river view.



Friday – Day 21

Accommodation at Kalahari Bush Breaks in a Luxury Campsite on a Self-catering basis for 1 night.

The Kalahari Desert is a vast sandveld region which extends over central and western Botswana into eastern Namibia and the Northern Cape. Although generally described as a desert, the typical Kalahari landscape is surprisingly well-vegetated. At Kalahari Bush Breaks you are surrounded by primordial, enthralling savannas while the ambience of the guest house itself is both natural and luxurious. You can relax in comfort while taking in a unique and unspoilt landscape- certainly the best of both worlds. The garden is shaded by worm-bark false-thorn trees (*Albizia Anthelmintica*) and overlooks a floodlit waterhole where game and birds flock during the day. Natural building materials were used. The three-levelled thatched complex and 2 Chalets can accommodate up to sixteen people (plus 2 guides) sharing. There are eight bedrooms, two which are equipped with double beds, and all have en-suite bathrooms. The partly covered lapa can be referred to as the "heart" of the guest house with open fireplace, a kitchen and bar facilities.
